The Louis Stokes Alliances for Minority participation (LSAMP) program of the National Science Foundation assists universities and colleges in their efforts to increase underrepresented minority student recruitment, retention, persistence, and attainment of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) degrees. It does this by the formation of alliances and carrying out specific programming. The Tennessee Valley State LSAMP Alliance consists of 3 four-year institutions and 1 community college: University of North Alabama, University of Tennessee Martin, Mississippi University for Women, and Northwest Shoals Community College.

In order to be eligible to participate in the Tennessee Valley State Alliance, students must:

- ” Be an underrepresented minority as described by the LSAMP Program Description (African American, Hispanic, American Indian, Alaskan Native, Native Hawaiian, Native Pacific Islander)
- ” Be a U.S. citizen, U.S. national, or permanent resident of the U.S. or its possessions
- ” Be enrolled at a participating institution in an undergraduate major in a STEM discipline
