



Right to Request a Review If your eligibility for Title IV aid has been suspended because you have not met one or more of three standards of academic progress, you may request a review of that suspension to the University Committee on Student Financial Aid. You must have experienced unusual circumstances that affected your ability to meet those standards in order to appeal.

Definition. A transfer year adjustment for example, is probably not a truly unusual circumstance.

Review Process Requests for review are screened and considered individually and independently by the University Committee on Student Financial Aid. It takes 2-3 weeks for complete review and more time during interim periods. If you submit a written request for review, you will be notified via email or letter of the decision, which is final. Check your UL email.
